This was designed to provide shelter and leisure seating space for hospital commuters. This design was aimed at using low cost, recycled materials for the building of outdoor furniture. There project was one of three colleges participated in the event from architecture schools in Bangalore and executed by students with the budget of 10,000/- from management of Gopalan Foundation.

College work was shortlisted as one of the 100 entries from a total of 380 entries. GSAP will involve in community activity for appropriate intervention of design in public environments.
